
This book will enclose all the further policy making context lines, combining practice and theory, academic knowledge and policy drafting, towards their mutual interaction.

The book will include:


- Best practices.

#### **MULTIPLIER EVENTS**


Multiplier events are workshops to be organised in each partner country. The purpose is to formally launch the results to the local public, in order to

### 3RD TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING

5th - 6th April 2022

#### LILLE, FRANCE

On 5th and 6th April the partners of ACCESS4ALL met face-to-face in Lille, for its 3rd Transnational Project Meeting (TPM).

The **first day** was dedicated to reviewing all the results reached so far and the tasks to be addressed from now until the end of the project. There was also room to discuss financial issues, dissemination, and the evaluation of the project.



On the **second day,** we had the opportunity to visit <u>AlterEos</u> (www.altereos.fr), an adapted company, flagship of the Social and Solidarity Economy (SSE).

We toured their facilities, where we could see how all the workplaces were adapted for people with different disabilities, and we discussed with their workers the main obstacles encountered in the labour market.



The consortium will meet for the last time at the Final Conference in Athens in October 2022.
